Welcome Back to School! School Bus Safety Tips for Students

- 1. Safety Starts at the Bus Stop Arrive at the bus stop 5 minutes before it is scheduled to arrive. Visit the bus stop with your child so you can show them where to safely wait for the bus. Students should be at least six feet away from the curb and be reminded that the bus stop is not a place to run around and horseplay.
- 2. Get On and Off the Bus Safely Wait until the bus comes to a complete stop, the doors open and the driver says it is okay to board before walking towards the school bus. Make sure to use the handrails for safety.

3. Use Caution Around the Bus - Never walk behind the school bus. If your child must cross the street in front of the bus, instruct them to walk on a sidewalk or along the side of the street at least 10 feet in front of the bus. Your child should make eye contact with the bus driver before crossing to make sure the driver can see you.

4. Be Safe on the Bus - Always sit in your seat when the bus is moving.
Use quiet voices on the bus and always listen to your bus driver's instructions - their job is to keep you safe on your way to and from school!
